

# **RECONSTRUCTING SR 32**

### Welcome to the Reconstructing SR 32 newsletter. The information is current based on the date it is printed (April 18, 2024).

#### **About the Project**

Reconstructing SR 32 is an important project due to the pavement on this section of the road reaching the end of its useful life and needing replacement. Properly maintaining this infrastructure requires replacing this section of pavement, including addressing drainage issues. Part of the overall project includes intersection improvements along SR 37. #### Phase 1 Construction Ending Soon

Weather permitting, construction will be ending in the next two weeks for Phase 1, which is the intersection of SR 32 and 16th Street. Construction began earlier this month, and crews have been replacing the pavement and reconstructing storm sewer lines in the area.



#### **Phase 2 Construction Begins**

Crews will be moving to Phase 2 soon, which includes construction on SR 32 from 9th Street to 14th Street. Weather permitting, this work will begin April 23 and is anticipated to last until early June. During this phase, crews will be replacing pavement and reconstructing portions of the storm sewer in the area. Given the historic nature of this area, we will be preserving the existing trees and sidewalks to the best extent possible.

Downtown Noblesville businesses are still open, and pedestrian detours are available for anyone visiting the shops or restaurants. See attached map for more details.

Downtown Noblesville is home to many locally owned shops and restaurants. We encourage you to continue shopping and eating at these small businesses as construction continues in the area. We have been working with local
